STORAGE TIPS

- 1. Consider a disc type lock for the best overall protection.
- 2. Ventilation is important to keeping storage items fresh. When possible, leave gaps between items.
- 3. Beware of covering stored items with plastic as moisture will collect under it.
- 4. Talk to a qualified agent about renter's insurance on the contents of your unit. KBI Real Estate, LLC is not responsible for damaged or stolen contents.
- 5. To prevent mildew, black appliance doors open so they cannot seal out fresh air.
- 6. Using pallets to keep items off the floor allows air to circulate and protects against moisture.
- 7. Label your boxes and arrange them so they can bee seen for easy reference.
- 8. Consider the effects of seasonal temperature and humidity changes on each item stored.
- 9. Using boxes or containers of uniform size will make stacking more efficient. Fill them to the top and put light ones on top.
- 10. Try to place most valuable items toward the back.
- 11.Do not store flammable materials or liquids.
- 12. Allow yourself some space to get around.
- 13.To ensure proper credit, put your unit number on all payments and correspondence.
